ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The information provided below is for reference only. Please refer to the admissions website for details.

General Admissions Requirements

- (a) For Taught Doctoral Programmes:
 - A Master's degree from a recognized university.
- (b) For Master's Programmes:
 - A Bachelor's degree from a recognized university, normally with honours not lower than second class; or
 - A Bachelor's degree from an honours programme of a recognized university, normally with an average grade of not lower than "B".
- (c) For Postgraduate Diploma Programmes:
 - A Bachelor's degree from a recognized university.

English Language Requirements for Admission

- (a) A degree from a university in Hong Kong or a degree for which the programme medium of instruction was English; or
- (b) Scores in the following English Language tests*:
 - TOEFL: 550 (paper-based)/79 (internet-based);
 - IELTS (Academic): 6.5;
 - GMAT (Verbal): Band 21; or
- (c) A pass grade in English in one of the following examinations: HKALE (AS Level), HKHLE, CUHK Matriculation Examination, GCE A-Level/AS-Level; or
- (d) Level 4 or above in the English Language subject of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination; or
- (e) A recognized professional qualification, provided that the examination was conducted in English.

Programme-specific Admissions Requirements (if any)

* TOEFL and IELTS are considered valid for 2 years from the test date. GMAT is considered valid for 5 years from the test date. Some programmes may have a higher score requirement. Please refer to the relevant programme website for details.
