### PhD in Clinical Psychology

This programme, offered in full-time mode, will provide advanced research and clinical training to master-level clinical psychologists to raise their standards of professional practice and academic/research competence. The aim of the programme is to train future leaders in the clinical psychology profession, preparing graduates of this programme for senior posts in either tertiary educational institutions or practice settings.

## Admission Requirements

In addition to the general requirements of the Graduate School<sup>1</sup>, applicants should

1. possess a Master's degree in Clinical Psychology; and
2. have eligibility for membership of the Division of Clinical Psychology, Hong Kong Psychological Society.

Knowledge of spoken Cantonese and written Chinese is required (Courses are taught in Cantonese and English).
