

- 74% of the research performed by CUHK's 841 staff members is rated as world leading (29.09%) or internationally excellent (44.91%).
- Over 70% of the Faculty of Arts' research outputs in eight disciplines were rated as "world leading" or "internationally excellent".

RPg Peer Buddy Scheme

- To provide RPg students with a support network of peers outside their own programmes.
- Academic Advisory System

- From 2020-2023, our students:
 - presented over 505 conference papers
 - logged over 465 conference participations
 - Post-graduation Placement and Careers
 - From 2020-2022, around 48% PhD graduates were successful in securing academic posts





Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme

- Stipend (HK\$331,200 (approx. US\$42,460) / year) With provision of Conference and Research-related Travel Allowance (HK\$13,800 (approx. US\$1,760) / year)
- Tuition Fee waiver
- Lodging Award
- Hostel Fee waiver
- Usually open for application from Sep to Nov in each year

CUHK Vice-Chancellor PhD Scholarship

- A regular PhD place with the CUHK Vice-Chancellor PhD Scholarship will be offered to PhD candidate who got nominated to the RGC by CUHK but not selected for HKPFS.
- The Scholarship offers:
 - An award of a total HK\$80,000 (approx. US\$10,260)Studentships of HK\$220,320 (approx. US\$28,250)
 - Conference and Research-related Travel Allowance of HK\$30,000 (approx. US\$3,846)
