## Programme

#### **MPhil Stream**

This programme is the first postgraduate programme in Hong Kong designed specifically for the training of professional industrialorganizational psychologists. Students will receive comprehensive training in utilizing psychological knowledge for improving organizational effectiveness and employee satisfaction. Students are required to complete a minimum of 31 units of courses (excluding thesis research courses).

#### PhD Stream

The objective of this programme is to train students to make independent contributions to the advancement of psychological knowledge. Students are required to complete a minimum of 42 units of courses (excluding thesis research courses), pass a candidacy examination, and submit a research thesis and pass an oral examination for graduation.

#### Admission Requirements

In addition to the general requirements of the Graduate School<sup>1</sup>, applicants should

#### MPhil Stream

- possess a Bachelor's degree in Psychology or equivalent; and
- obtain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above.

#### PhD Stream

- possess a Bachelor's degree in Psychology or equivalent;
- obtain an overall GPA of 3.5 or above or honours not lower than Second Class Upper; and
- have completed an individually supervised research thesis.

#### MPhil Stream

 a statement of career aspiration and research interest (750 words in English).

#### PhD Stream

- a research proposal in English (2,500 words of above); and
- a statement of career aspiration and research interest (750 words in English).
