### **MPhil Stream**

Students are required:

- 1. To complete 12 units of lecture courses
- 2. To register for thesis research courses each term and
- 3. To complete the M.Phil thesis and pass the oral examination.

Students with good academic performance in their first year of study can apply to be transfered to the Ph.D stream.

#### **PHD Stream**

Students are required:

- 1. To complete 12 units of lecture courses in the pre-candidacy stage
- 2. To register for thesis research courses each term
- 3. To pass the candidacy examination
- 4. To complete the Ph.D thesis and pass the oral examination.

# Admission Requirements

In addition to the general requirement of the Graduate School<sup>1</sup>,

- Applicants are required to submit a 3-page proposal written in English (including research topic, research summary, previous research regarding the topic, methodology employed and references). Applicants may be required to attend an interview.
- Japanese language proficiency requirements may vary according to the areas of study and the content of the research proposal and is to be decided by the Graduate Panel.
