MPhil in Translation

Students are required to complete at least 24 units of courses, including "Advanced Translation Studies", "Research Seminar in Translation I", "Research Seminar in Translation II" and "Thesis Supervision". They will meet regularly with their supervisor(s) for discussions on their research topic, complete a dissertation and go through an oral examination. The Division may also require students to take additional courses if necessary.

PhD in Translation

Students are required to complete "Research Seminar in Translation II", "Research Seminar in Translation II" and "Thesis Supervision". They will meet regularly with their supervisor(s) for discussions on their research topic. They must pass a qualifying examination, complete a dissertation and go through an oral examination. The Division may also require students to take additional courses if necessary.

Students must pass the qualifying examination within the maximum period stipulated below (calculated from the date of admission) before they can be promoted to PhD candidature.

with research Master's Degree : Full-time 24 months
Part-time 32 months

After passing the qualifying examination, candidates will proceed to complete their theses.
